The purpose of this document is to serve as understanding of the expectations of enrollment in an AP course. Therefore, we understand:

- The student must meet any pre-requisites for the AP course(s) selected to be eligible to enroll.
- Students in AP courses typically have a heavier workload in regards to assignments, and AP students may be required to complete coursework over the summer and prior to the start of school in the fall.
- Students are expected to enroll for the year-long course; drops and adds for AP courses are limited.
- Students electing to take the AP Exam for the course(s) are expected to pay a deposit for the AP Exam in March of the school calendar year and the remaining balance on the test date. (For example this year there was a \$15.00 deposit due in March and the remaining balance of approximately \$78.00 will be due in May before the actual test date, total cost equals approximately \$93.00. The test fee may vary from year to year. As you can see this is a substantial savings when compared to tuition for a 3-credit course at the University level, if the student attains a qualifying score.)

At this time we would like to confirm your course selection choice and that you are aware of the expectations and costs associated with AP coursework at FHS.

Please sign the bottom of the letter and return it to the High School Guidance Office by **Friday, March 17, 2017**, along with your Course Request Sheet. *If this letter is not returned by this date, we will assume your son/daughter has elected not to take the AP course(s) originally requested.*
